

Sign the Pledge to Resist FBI and Grand Jury Repression

23 anti-war and international solidarity activists - including 9 from **Minneapolis** - were subpoenaed to appear before a grand jury in Chicago. All refused to testify against our movements for peace and justice. **Their courage could have consequences.** Some could have extended jail time for refusing to testify. Others could be indicted at any time.



The feds say they are investigating “material support” for “foreign terrorist organizations.” Those targeted have done nothing of the kind - they have only spoken the truth against U.S. wars and against terrible regimes abroad that are sponsored by U.S. government. The subpoenas are an assault on our rights to freedom of association and freedom of speech.

In September 2010, the FBI raided homes and an office, confiscating computers, papers, organizing materials and lists. *Since then, many others have been harassed by the FBI.*

Why we should all sign the Pledge:

1. Be first on the action-alert list if there are more subpoenas or if indictments happen.
2. Take a stand for our rights to speak out for justice.

Text of the pledge: Actions planned if anti-war and international solidarity activists are called to Grand Jury or indicted!

23 anti-war and international solidarity activists have been subpoenaed to appear in front of a Grand Jury in Chicago, headed by U.S. Attorney Patrick Fitzgerald. They have done nothing wrong. They have educated and organized against U.S. wars around the world. And they have stood in solidarity with the peoples of Palestine and Colombia.

All 23 of the targeted activists said that they will not cooperate with this witch hunt against the movements so many of us have worked to build. The U.S. attorney is working to put these activists in prison. Whether some of them are indicted, or others are jailed for refusing to testify, the threat is very real.

We pledge:

- * We will carry forward the fight for our right to speak out, organize and to stand in solidarity with those who want freedom;
- * We will stand up to any escalation of the attacks on anti-war and international solidarity activists;
- * We will join the national day of protest when anti-war and international solidarity activists are ordered to appear in front of the Chicago Grand Jury or indicted.
